Belgian decorator Victoria-Maria Geyer has long been an ardent lover of Pierre Frey fabric house, using an array of its textiles in many of her projects. So it's no surprise that she has collaborated with the brand on a capsule fabric and wallpaper collection featuring her own imaginative illustrations. Les Venimeuses – or The Venemous – consists of two designs in rust, midnight blue or gun barrel grey: the first (pictured above) depicts a swirl of serpents reminiscent of 18th century animal engravings, while the second is composed of the Ouroboros, an ancient Egyptian symbol portraying a snake eating its own tail.
